4. Over the course of the next several months, my husband and I spoke with the birth mother nearly once a week. Our conversations were pleasant and the birth mother reaffirmed her desire to pursue an adoption plan.

5. On or about August 3, 2004, my husband and I traveled to Edison, New Jersey, in order to meet the birth mother prior to her due date. Our meeting with the birth mother went well and was a very positive experience.

6. On September 22, 2004, the birth mother gave birth to a baby boy. We stayed with the birth mother and the child at the hospital until they were released from the hospital on September 24, 2004.

7. We took our baby boy home to New Jersey on September 24.

8. (If intermediary) We have paid no money to Felicia Friend for making the introductions for us. No one else served in any intermediary capacity.
