

In-Home Entertainment and Companions.

 - g. The day of the week when such entertainment occurs.
3. If any child was present at the time that the entertainment, referred to in your answer to the previous interrogatory, took place, please state as to each such child:
 - a. The name of the person supervising such child during such entertainment,
 - b. Whether such child was allowed to eat with and/or mingle with the guests,
