1. Within the past five years, have you smoked within your home?
2. If your answer to the preceding interrogatory is in the affirmative, please describe in detail your frequency of smoking on a daily, weekly or more occasional basis.
3. If, within the past five years, you have smoked in your home, please describe in detail the type of smoking materials used or consumed indicating whether cigarettes, cigars, pipe tobacco, marijuana, hashish, or other.
4. If, within the past five years, you have smoked in your home, please indicate the amount of smoking material of each type consumed by you on a daily, weekly or more occasional basis.
5. If, within the past five years, you have smoked in your home, please state:
 - a. The identity of persons present when you have smoked,
 - b. The child's exposure to smoking,
 - c. Where the smoking occurs in your home,
 - d. The cost of each kind of smoking material consumed on a weekly basis.
6. If, within the past five years, other persons have smoked in your home, please state:
 - a. The identity of other smokers in your home,
 - b. The frequency and type of smoking materials consumed by others,
 - c. The identity of the persons present when others smoked in your home,
 - d. The child's exposure to others smoking in your home.

 - d. The average amount of bet or risked on each kind of gambling on a daily, weekly or monthly basis,

- e. The average amount that you have won or lost on each kind of gambling on a daily, weekly or monthly basis.

Discipline and Punishment.

 - a. Spanking the child with your hand,
 - b. Hitting the child with any belt or other item,
 - c. Sending the child to the corner of any room, to a closet, or to his or her room,
 - d. Locking the child in a closet or his or her room,
 - e. "grounding" to the house,
 - f. Suspending allowance,
 - g. Suspending television viewing,
 - h. Suspending other rights or privileges,
 - i. Verbal punishment or scolding,
 - j. Other.
